Google gives in Fairfax County

[Google](#), which leased about 15,000 square feet of office space in Reston this summer, is making plans to give a little back to the community.

The Mountain View, Calif.-based Internet search engine giant Tuesday announced philanthropic partnerships with the Fairfax County Public Schools and with nonprofit Reston Interfaith, which serves the Fairfax County shelter for the homeless, to donate services and technology.

Google's (NASDAQ: GOOG) federal enterprise sales team now occupies space at 1818 Library Street in [Reston Town Center](#). It currently has about 30 employees there.

The Reston space is in addition to Google's lobbying office at 1101 New York Ave. NW, which it leased about a year ago.
