Alan Fogg is vice president for communications at the Fairfax County Economic Development Authority (FCEDA, [www.FairfaxCountyEDA.org](http://www.FairfaxCountyEDA.org)), which promotes Fairfax County as one of the world's best business locations. Business growth helps Fairfax County fund the nation's top-rated school system and library, park, public safety and human services that contribute to the quality of life of residents.
