Headquarters Offices



Fairfax County, Virginia, offers many compelling location advantages for headquarters operations—a favorable business climate, easy access to domestic and international markets, a highly educated workforce and an enviable quality of life. Many corporate, North American, U.S. and divisional headquarters of some of the largest and fastest-growing companies in the world are here.

A Favorable Business Climate

Fairfax County maintains the highest AAA bond rating and is consistently regarded as one of the most stable and best-managed local governments in the U.S.

Virginia has the fourth lowest corporate tax burden in the nation.

Numerous chambers of commerce, associations, networking groups and forums are active throughout the Washington, D.C., region. Many top-tier business services in the county provide advice and resources in law, advertising, accounting, finance and technology.

More than 375 foreign-owned or affiliated companies—the largest number in the metro Washington area—are located in Fairfax County. Proximity to other headquarters here helps facilitate partnerships and new business collaborations. Embassies, close by in Washington, can provide support and assistance to firms interested in entering international markets.

Fairfax County is within a short drive of downtown Washington, home of the federal government—the largest customer of goods and services in the world.

Easy Market Access

Sixty percent of the U.S. population is within a day's drive or two-hour flight of Fairfax County.

Headquarters staff can travel anywhere in the world conveniently and economically through three major airports serving the greater Washington region: Washington Dulles International Airport, Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and Baltimore-Washington International Airport.

Amtrak train and bus service is also available from Fairfax to major metro areas on the east coast, including New York City.

Highly Educated Workforce

Fairfax County companies have access to a large labor pool of highly educated workers. More than 58 percent of county residents over age 25 hold a bachelor's degree or higher, compared to 28 percent nationally. The surrounding Washington region has the highest level of educational attainment among all major metropolitan areas in the country.

The concentration of headquarters operations in Fairfax County and the Washington region has created a robust managerial and executive labor pool from which other companies can recruit.

More than 65 colleges and universities in the Washington area offer credit and continuing education courses, enabling employees to stay up-to-date with current technology and industry developments.

A Quality of Life that Attracts and Retains Business Talent

The Fairfax County Public Schools system (FCPS; www.fcps.edu), one of the highest-rated school systems in America, offers many unique programs, including a nationally recognized Foreign Language Immersion Program, the International Baccalaureate (IB) Program and Advanced Placement courses. The Washington area's numerous private schools offer parents additional education options for their children (www.nces.ed.gov/surveys/pss/privateschoolsearch).

With a temperate climate and 50 square miles (129.5 square kilometers) of public parkland available, residents can enjoy a wide variety of outdoor activities, including biking, hiking, tennis and golf.

Nearly 300 cultural organizations, including theater and opera companies, music and dance groups, and community arts centers and festivals, are based in and around the county. The cultural riches of Washington, such as the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, the National Gallery of Art, the Corcoran, and dozens of alternative clubs, galleries and performance spaces, are just minutes away by car or Metrorail. The area also is home to professional baseball, basketball, football, ice hockey and soccer teams.
