## Corporate Headquarters



Fairfax County offers many compelling location advantages for headquarters operations—a favorable business climate, easy access to domestic and international markets, a highly educated workforce and an enviable quality of life. Corporate, North American, U.S. and divisional headquarters of some of the largest and fastest-growing companies in the world, representing a broad range of industry sectors, are located here.

### Business-Friendly Climate

- Virginia has the sixth-lowest corporate tax burden in the U.S.
- One of the most stable and best-managed local governments in the country, Fairfax County maintains the highest possible AAA bond rating.
- Numerous chambers of commerce, associations and networking groups are active throughout the region.
- Top-tier professional service providers in law, advertising, accounting, finance and technology.

### Market Access

- Proximity to Washington, D.C., provides access to the federal government—the largest customer of goods and services in the world.
- More than 400 foreign-owned companies are located in Fairfax County. Foreign embassies in the nation's capital provide assistance to firms interested in entering international markets.
- Proximity to other corporate headquarters helps facilitate partnerships and business collaborations.
- Sixty percent of the U.S. population is within a day's drive or two-hour flight of Fairfax County.
- Headquarters staff can travel almost anywhere in the world through three major regional airports: Washington Dulles International Airport, Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and Thurgood Marshall Baltimore-Washington International Airport.
- Amtrak train and bus service is available from Fairfax County to major metro areas on the east coast, including New York City.

### Talented Workforce

- Fairfax County companies have access to a large labor pool of highly educated workers. More than 60 percent of county residents over age 25 hold a bachelor's degree or higher, compared to 30 percent nationally. The Washington region has one of the highest levels of educational attainment among all major metropolitan areas in the country.
- The concentration of headquarters operations in Fairfax County and the Washington area has created a robust managerial and executive labor pool.
- Sixty colleges and universities in the Washington area offer credit and continuing education courses, enabling employees to stay up-to-date with technology and industry developments.

### A Quality of Life that Attracts Business Talent

- Fairfax County Public Schools is one of the highest-rated school systems in the country and offers many unique programs, including Foreign Language Immersion, the International Baccalaureate Program, and Advanced Placement courses. Numerous private schools offer additional education options.
- With a temperate climate and 50 square miles of public parkland, residents enjoy a wide variety of outdoor activities, including biking, hiking, tennis and golf.
- Cultural organizations, including theater, music and community arts centers and festivals, are based in and around the county. The cultural riches of Washington, such as the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, the National Gallery of Art and the Smithsonian museums, are just minutes away. The area also is home to professional baseball, basketball, football, ice hockey and soccer teams.
